WHEREAS, the Town of Jean Lafitte acknowledges the importance of the oil and gas industry acting as responsible corporate citizens when operating in and along the coast of Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Jean Lafitte acknowledges the importance of holding those in the oil and gas industry who do not act as responsible corporate citizens responsible for the consequences of their actions.
